I know some of you have asked if you can give some of your stimulus money to help the community and this would be a great way to do so.

Third, we do need some volunteers. Deacon Kim is managing the volunteers for this outreach. We will keep the team under ten people, keep social distancing, and wear masks and gloves. We need healthy parishioners to help with directing the vehicles, plating the food, and servers to bring the meals to the cars. If you are interested, please call Deacon Kim to be added to the list.
