We have an opportunity to minister to our local community. The Lake Cares Food Pantry is now desperately low on food for our neighbors in need. The need has increased with unemployment on the rise and the giving has decreased with people staying home and churches not meeting in person. So here are two ways we can help.

Starting this Saturday, we will have a drop off table outside of the church near Hartridge Hall so that you can donate some food items. The table will be available each Saturday from 10 AM to Noon. The food will then be delivered to Lake Cares. They need canned items such as soup, fruit, tuna, proteins (meat, stew, etc.), peanut butter, and vegetables. You may bring other items too.

A second way to help is by volunteering on the days they distribute food. The shifts are Tuesday, Wednesday, and Saturday mornings, and also on Wednesday afternoons. Volunteers direct traffic as folks drive through to obtain a bag of food; they also assist in bagging the food. The food bank staff and volunteers adhere to CDC guidelines such as social distancing.
